Course Requirement


- Applicants must be <u>HKCFRS&S Valid Member of Affiliated Club or Association</u>.
- Anyone aged 18 or above who is interested in the sport of skateboarding and who aspires to become a skateboarding judge and official
- Must have an adequate level of Skateboarding experience.

Technical Regulation



<u>Remarks</u>

- 1. Each course will be maximum 25 participants. Signing up for course is therefore under a first-come first-serve based.
- 2. Instruction language will be in Putonghua, Cantonese and English. Lecture notes will be mainly in English.
- 3. Course Fee is non-refundable. Once the application is accepted, the course fees will not be refunded.
- 4. All applicants must attend at least 90% lesson of the course (90% attendance); otherwise the participant will be disqualified from both Written Examination and Field Examination.
- 5. Only the participants, who complete the lessons, pass the examinations and complete practical, can be awarded to the certificate of HKCFRS&S Level I Skateboarding Judges & Officials Training Course.
- 6. Participates have to complete <u>No Less than 16 hours Practical</u> within 12 months after the last lesson of the course.
- 7. All participants will be qualified to register as a valid Registered Skateboarding Judge in HKCFRS&S once they completed in practical.
- 8. If applicant cannot provide sufficient documents or valid cheque within the application period, the HKCFRS&S reserves the authority to reject the application.
- 9. HKCFRS&S reserves the right to request the applicant to provide the proof of qualifications / experience in skateboarding industry.
- 10. All applicants must arrange their own personal accident insurance.
- 11. HKCFRS&S reserves the right to accept or reject the application.
- 12. HKCFRS&S reserves the right to make any change in the course and decision should be final. HKCFRS&S will announce the change to the participants as early as possible.
- 13. In case of any discrepancy between the English version and the Chinese version, the English version shall prevail.
